ROLE DESCRIPTION

OBJECTIVE

Educate the community about the benefit of organ and tissue donation by speaking to groups interested in learning more about donation.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide prepared speaking material to groups such as: civic organizations, high school health classes, church groups, businesses partnered with ARORA, and more
 - Initial speaking engagements will be supervised by ARORA staff members, or may be in conjunction with other speakers to include other ARORA Ambassadors, donor families, recipients, or ARORA staff members
- Identify speaking engagement possibilities within the community and inform ARORA Communications or Donation Development staff
- Advocate for organ and tissue donation as means of restoring lives in the community

QUALIFICATIONS

- Knowledge and understanding of ARORA and the organ and tissue donation process
- Willingness to speak publicly about organ and tissue donation
- Ability to answer questions about organ and tissue donation and provide accurate information in a professional manner
- Must be 21 years of age or older. If under 21, may speak with an adult family member over the age of 21.
- Complete ARORA volunteer packet containing:
 - Volunteer Code of Conduct
 - Volunteer Application

TRAINING

- Must complete mandatory ARORA Volunteer Training and refresher trainings.
- Observation and a satisfactory evaluation by the Aftercare, Donation Development, and Communications Department staff members is required prior to speaking to groups without an ARORA staff member present.
- Understand history and clarity statements of ARORA, including
 - Mission Statement
