COMMUNITY OUTREACH VOLUNTEER

ROLE DESCRIPTION

OBJECTIVE

Educate the community about the benefit of organ and tissue donation by interacting with the public at health fair booths, community events such as fairs or festivals.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide prepared materials (brochures and branded giveaway items) to the public
- Answer questions about organ and tissue donation
- Assist in registering individuals who wish to become registered organ and tissue donors
- Identify community outreach possibilities within your community and inform ARORA Communications or Donation Development staff
- Document interactions and relay data to ARORA staff
- Advocate for organ and tissue donation as means of restoring lives in your community

QUALIFICATIONS

- Knowledge and understanding of ARORA and the organ and tissue donation process
- Willingness to interact with the public at community events and to advocate for organ and tissue donation
- Ability to answer questions about organ and tissue donation and provide accurate information in a professional manner
- Must be 18 years of age or older. Volunteers under the age of 18 will be considered on a case by case basis depending on the type of community event and knowledge level of donation.
- Complete ARORA volunteer packet containing:
 - Volunteer Code of Conduct
 - Volunteer Application

TRAINING

- Must complete mandatory ARORA Volunteer Orientation and refresher trainings.
- Understand history and clarity statements of ARORA, including
 - Mission Statement
 - Core Purpose
