Dear Mr. Ward and Dr. Fiser:

At its meeting on July 26, 2012, the OPTN/UNOS Membership and Professional Standards Committee (MPSC) reviewed the results of a routine on-site survey of Arkansas Regional Organ Recovery Agency conducted on February 21-22, 2012.

Arkansas Regional Organ Recovery Agency had a clinical compliance score of 96 percent and an administrative compliance score of 75 percent. Violations identified in the on-site survey included OPTN Policies 2.2.4 (Donor Evaluation), 7.1.7 (Reporting Definitions), and 7.5 (Submission of Donor Information). In response, the OPO submitted a corrective action plan (CAP) following the on-site survey. The MPSC recommends that the program continue to follow the CAP in order to avoid similar occurrences of non-compliance.

Based on its review, the MPSC approved the following recommendation:

**RESOLVED**, that the Membership and Professional Standards Committee closes the review of Arkansas Regional Organ Recovery Agency with no action.

The Committee voted 33 For; 0 Against; and 0 Abstentions.
